Day 01 Arrive Kuching

Meet upon arrival at the Kuching International Airport. Transfer to your city hotel.

Day 02 Bako National Park / Kuching

B/L

Breakfast at the hotel. Then departure for your day trip to the **Bako National Park**.

Bako is the oldest gazetted national park in Sarawak. It offers the perfect introduction to Sarawak flora and fauna. The 16 square kilometres of primary forests is home to seven distinct ecosystems; beach vegetation, cliff vegetation, mangrove, peat swamp forests, mixed dipterocarp forest, heath forest and grasslands.

Constant erosion over millions of years has turned the Bako coastline into a unique geographical landmark. Cliff faces, sandstone structures, sea stacks and pristine sandy beaches dot the area. Wildlife include the rather intrusive long tailed macaques which roam all over and their shier cousins, the silver leaf monkeys and the rare, long-nosed, pot bellied proboscis monkey. Other denizens include flying lemur, mouse deer, bearded pigs, bats, tarsiers, slow loris and palm civet cats. Please note that these animals are wild and therefore, there is no guarantee that visitors will see them.

Lunch at the Park canteen and return to the city by mid-afternoon for drop off at your hotel. Leisure.

Day 03 Semenggoh Nature Reserve & 2D1N Lemanak River

Early morning departure to visit the **Semenggoh Orang Utan Rehabilitation Centre**. The entire facility occupies an area of 740 acres, the only remaining green belt which acts as a sanctuary for Orang Utans and other wildlife, this near the city. The Centre is a temporary home for displaced Orang Utans that have been rescued from captivity or young orphaned primates. These animals are trained or re-trained to survive in their natural surroundings. There are feeding times scheduled everyday at the feeding platform. However always bear in mind that the main aim of the Centre is to return these animals back into their habitat. Do not be disappointed if you do not see any roaming the jungles or coming back to feed as this means they are able to forage on their own and do not need human assistance.

From there depart on your **2D1N Lemanak River Longhouse adventure**. The journey to the Lemanak River takes 4 hours (232 km). Along the way, pass *padi* (rice) fields, pepper plantations, roadside *kampungs* and have lunch at a tiny little town. At the river, native longboats take you up to an Iban longhouse. Along this river live the famous Ibans who were once fearsome pirates and headhunters. Today they live harmoniously as farmers, fishing and hunting in the surrounding jungles. Arrive at the longhouse in the late afternoon. Enjoy a simple dinner before an evening of traditional music and dance, filled with many rounds of *tuak*, the native rice wine. Overnight at the River Lodge.

Day 04 Lemanak / Kuching

Breakfast at the Guesthouse. Take part in a blowpipe and cockfight demonstration before proceeding for a nature walk to visit native farms and an Iban burial ground. Later return to the river jetty for your journey back to the city.

Lunch at Ranchan Waterfall, a scenic series of falls with refreshing cool water. Continue on to the city. Drop off at your city hotel. Free at leisure.

Day 05 City Tour / Sarawak Cultural Village

B/L/D

Morning departure on a **brief sightseeing tour** of Kuching after breakfast. It is a city of contrasts which is represented by the architectural styles, from the structures of the White Rajahs and British colonial eras to modern concrete and steel high-rise. Your tour includes stops at the Cat Monument, the oldest Chinese Temple in the city and a visit to the famed Sarawak Museum **or** Cat Museum (both closed on first day of public holidays). Drive through quaint Malay **kampungs** and the heart of the city. If time permits, take a walk on the Waterfront with its outdoor cafes and watch sampans plying the Sarawak River ferrying passengers from one side of the river to the other. Lunch at local restaurant.

Transfer to Damai Peninsula at the foothills of the legendary Mount Santubong. Enjoy lunch at the Restoran Budaya and spend the afternoon visiting the **Sarawak Cultural Village**. Popularly known as SCV, the Village is a "living museum" showcasing the seven major ethnic races of Sarawak; Iban, Bidayuh, Penan, Orang Ulu, Melanau, Malay and Chinese. Visit each house to learn their cultures and traditions. Participate in their activities including craft making and preparing their various ethnic goodies. There are daily music and dance performances at the Village Theatre at 4.00 pm.

Return to the mainland for a late dinner. Drop off at your city hotel.

Day 06 Wind & Fairy Caves / Departure

Morning departure for the **Wind & Fairy Caves**. The caves were formed over one hundred million years ago and are primarily limestone. Stalactite and stalagmites feature in the caverns and for many generations, locals have worshipped the rock structures that resemble the human form or animals. You will find scattered makeshift altars, shrines and incense. Return to the city with lunch enroute. Drop off at the Kuching International Airport for your departure flight.
